Measuring the impact of PPG spending

In June 2013, KS2 results were;

- 100% L4+ in Maths, 38% L5
- 81% L4 + in Reading and 44% L5.
- 81% achieved L4 in both Maths and English.
- 100% made 2 levels or more progress in Maths and 88% made 2 levels progress in English
- All the children eligible for PPG, made 2 levels or more progress in English and Maths

We will continue to use this grant to enrich children's experiences to help them become increasingly confident in all aspects of learning.
