It was wonderful to see all the children dressed up this week for World Book day, they all looked amazing. Thank you to our wonderful parents for all of your efforts to help make it such a special day. The children enjoyed a special workshop delivered by Altru Drama Company. The children explored classic texts, learning about a range of texts, characters, themes and settings and having fun with 'old' books. They used drama techniques to explore some of this year's £1 books - encouraging children to pick up the books themselves and find a book that excites and inspires them. Finally. They imagined themselves as writers - identifying the sort of books they'd love to create in the future.

Year 6 also enjoyed our usually trip to Crucial Crew which teacher children life skills, they learnt about staying safe around train tracks, the effects of Carbon Monoxide, the dangers of Vaping and anti-social behaviour. I hope you'll agree that these life lessons are very important and support the children's transition into year 7.

NGL (which stands for 'Not Gonna Lie') is an app through which users share a link to their Instagram story or Twitter account, inviting their followers to give anonymous feedback.
