Glossary of Vocabulary

- 3D— Three dimensional work—usually a sculpture
- 2D— Two dimensional work—can be a painting
- Pop Art— Pop art is an art movement that emerged in the 1950s and flourished in the 1960s in America and Britain, drawing inspiration from sources in popular and commercial culture
- Cityscape— An Artists representation of a city
