Early Learning Goal:

Past and Present

Children at the expected level of development will:

Talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society.

Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class.

Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling.

Resources **Lesson ideas** Use the PINS in Mini Mash to pin the topics to the front of Mini Mash to allow the **Topic Pins:** (Mini Mash) children to access the resources. You can also access resources in Purple Mash by using the search tool in Purple mash People Who Help Us and searching for the resources. Vets **Builders** Lesson ideas: -Ask children what they know about these people and the roles they play in society. Builders How do these people help us? What do they provide for us?
