Glossary of Vocabulary

United Kingdom —is made up of 4 countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

Capital city— is the most important city in a country.

Europe—is the sixth largest continent.

Population—people who live in a particular area.

Exported goods—goods that are made in Europe and taken to other countries.

Imported goods—goods that are brought in from other countries into Europe.

Trade—is the buying and selling of goods.
