**Forest School:** This year we are lucky to be involved with Community Little Hulton who are running forest school session funded by the Healthy School Partnership grants from Salford CVS. The grant enables us to provide forest school workshops for two classes this year. The first class to participate was year 5 in October, followed by Year 1 in Spring Term. We are thrilled that our Reception class will now be receiving their session through the summer term. The sessions will be held within the school grounds for 1 hour and will take place in all-weather unless deemed unsafe. Site and risk assessments will be conducted before sessions begin. There will be an increased risk to minor injuries (stings from insects of nettles, bumps and scratches) due to the nature of the sessions. First aid will be administered by the forest school leader/class teacher if required. We feel this will be an exciting opportunity for the children enriching their learning experience.
