On Wednesday, Year 6 went on a trip to Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue Training Centre.

We learned valuable and interesting things, in this process we learned some CPR and when and if we should use it.

We had a turn in the Control Room to hear what an emergency call would be like and listen to how the call-handler responded.

We were taken around a pretend house and asked to find risks – there were lots to find! We learnt that we should check our smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms every week to make sure they work!

Y6 had a wonderful trip to fire and safety, they learnt all kind of things - everything went smoothly and we had a safe journey back to school.

Measles outbreak: Measles is caused by a virus and is highly infectious, in some cases it can lead to serious complications. **It begins like a cold with a runny nose, as well as a cough, fever, conjunctivitis (sore, red eyes). After about three days a rash begins over the face / head, before spreading across the rest of the body.** Measles is spread to others in the droplets of coughs or sneezes and is easily passed around families and communities if children and adults are unvaccinated. It can affect people of all ages but babies under one, pregnant women, and people with a weakened immune system are at greatest risk. There is no treatment for Measles, once someone has measles we can only try to ease their symptoms, therefore it is important to prevent, the best way is to get the MMR vaccine.

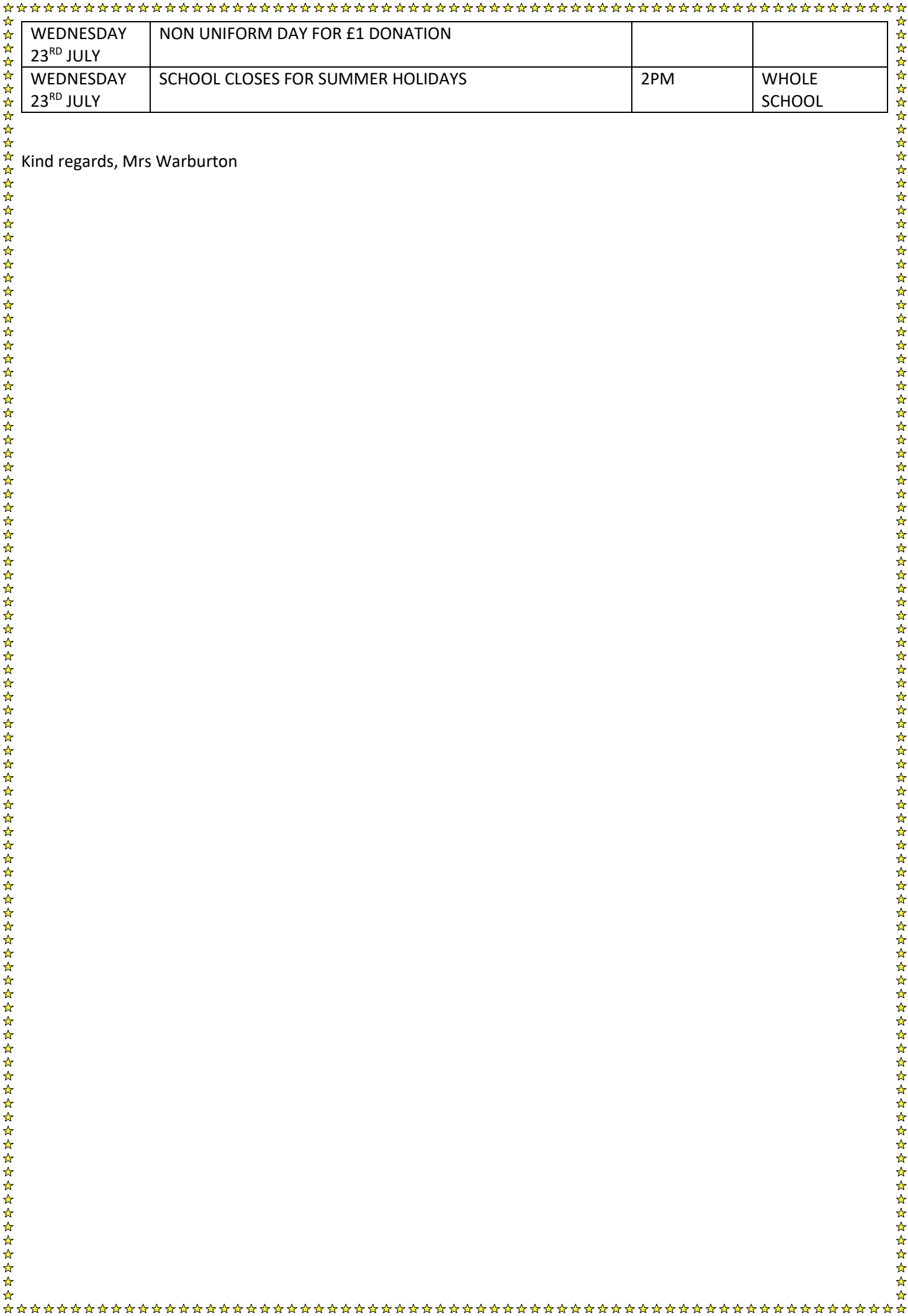
