Not only does reading for pleasure spark imagination and curiosity, but strong reading skills are essential for accessing the full curriculum and giving children the best opportunities in life. To support parents with <u>Read Write Inc. (RWI)</u>, alongside the reading books for home, there is access to online resources like the Ruth Miskin Literacy website,



and guidance on practicing sounds and "Red Words" (high-frequency sight words). Parents can support their child by practicing daily reading, using "Fred Talk" to blend sounds, and discussing books to build comprehension and enjoyment, with videos and tutorials available to help them understand the RWI program. It really is a partnership between school and parents that will help your child to blossom into a wonderful reader.



Year 4 enjoyed a lovely visit to **St John's Church** this week to learn about **Harvest** – a time to give thanks for the food we have and think about those in need. Thank you to St John's and the wonderful volunteers who always give such kind support to our school.

Although the corridors have felt a little quieter than usual... we think we know why!
