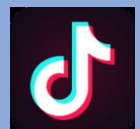

Attendance: Well done to years 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 for all achieving above 96% attendance and well done to Nursery and year 4 for all being on time, every day. Let's see if we can get all classes above 96% and everyone in on time every day next week! Each half term we will be looking at which children have achieved the required attendance target and congratulating them along with special

certificates for those with 100% attendance. The greater your child's attendance, the more learning time they have along with the time to build strong relationships with their friends.

Year 6 Trip to Stockport Air Raid Shelter: What a fantastic trip year 6 had this week, the children looked just the part in their WW2 costumes. They got to experience what it would have been like for children living through the war even going down into the air raid shelters deep underground. I think it made us realise how fortunate we are these days! I was particularly impressed with the children's behaviour, the feedback from the venue and the teachers was exceptional and I am extremely pleased with how the whole class represented the school – I am very proud of them all.
